Reading - Our focus for next week will be sequencing events in nonfiction texts and asking open ended questions while reading. We will also continue working with oi combinations and prefix and suffixes to increase our decoding skills.

Spelling- Every night students have to complete spelling homework with their spelling words. At their own pace, students must complete enough activities to earn 10 points by Friday. Students need to try to refrain from using the same activity more than once a week. Each new activity needs to be labeled with their name, date, activity \#, and point value.

Writing - In Writing Workshop next week we will continue to work on learning logs and writing persuasive letters.

Also if your student hasn't sent their Flat Stanley letter, please bring AN ENVELOPE, STAMP, AND ADDRESS OF WHERE THE LETTER IS TO BE SENT on Monday! We can't wait to see what kind of letters and pictures come back with Flat Stanley! If you receive a Flat Stanley letter response please send the letter, pictures, or anything else to school for us to put on display in the classroom.

Math -Next week we will work with more multiplication facts. We will also be learning more about different ways to collect \& display data in tables, charts, and graphs.

Homework - Each night students will have spelling homework, reading for 20 minutes, and a math homework page. Parents, remember to sign the reading log AND to sign each day in their Student Agendas.
