

“Speller’s Choice”

- Ⓢ Below is a list of activities that your child can complete at home for spelling homework practice.
- Ⓢ Complete the activities you choose in the spelling section of their homework binder.
- Ⓢ You must use your **Spelling Words** for the week for these activities.
- Ⓢ Please put your name, the date, activity name, and level on the top of each entry!!
- Ⓢ Students must complete 3 activities per week from any of the levels.
- Ⓢ Or you can adequately complete two Level IV activities for the week.
- Ⓢ Students can NOT do more than ONE level I per week!

Level I Activities

1. **ABC order**- Write your words in alphabetical order.
2. **Reference words** – Choose 5 of the words and look them up in a dictionary. Copy the first definition out of the dictionary.
3. **Repeat Words** – Write your words five times each.
4. **Rainbow Words**- Write each spelling word in a rainbow of colors.

Level II Activities:

5. **Complete sentences**- Use all of your words in ten sentences.
6. **Words-in-words** - Write your words and then write at least 2 words made from each.

Level III Activities:

7. **Secret Agent Words** - Number the alphabet from 1 to 26, and then convert your words to a number code.
8. **Word Search**- Go to Puzzlemaker.com and complete a word search, using all of your spelling words. Find and circle your words.
9. **30 Second Words** - Write a TV commercial using as many of the words from your list as possible.

Level IV Activities:

10. **Story words** - Write a short story using as many of your words as possible.
11. **Write a letter**- Write a letter to anyone of your choice using as many of the spelling words as possible. Make sure you include the components of a letter.
12. **Ransom words** - Write your words by cutting out letters in a newspaper or magazine and gluing them into your spelling journal.
