- Below is a list of activities that your child can complete at home for spelling homework practice.
- Complete the activities you choose in the spelling section of their homework binder.
- ⁽²⁾ You must use your **Spelling Words** for the week for these activities.
- Please <u>put your name, the date, activity name, and level</u> on the top of each entry!!
- ⁽²⁾ Students must complete 3 activities per week from any of the levels.
- ⁽²⁾ Or you can adequately complete two Level IV activities for the week.
- Students can NOT do more than ONE level I per week!

Level I Activities

- 1. **ABC order** Write your words in alphabetical order.
- 2. **Reference words** Choose 5 of the words and look them up in a dictionary. Copy the first definition out of the dictionary.
- 3. Repeat Words Write your words five times each.
- 4. **Rainbow Words** Write each spelling word in a rainbow of colors.

Level II Activities:

- 5. Complete sentences- Use all of your words in ten sentences.
- 6. Words-in-words Write your words and then write at least 2 words made from each.

Level III Activities:

- 7. Secret Agent Words Number the alphabet from 1 to 26, and then convert your words to a number code.
- 8. **Word Search** Go to Puzzlemaker.com and complete a word search, using all of your spelling words. Find and circle your words.
- 9. **30 Second Words** Write a TV commercial using as many of the words from your list as possible.

Level IV Activities:

- 10. Story words Write a short story using as many of your words as possible.
- 11. Write a letter- Write a letter to anyone of your choice using as many of the spelling words as possible. Make sure you include the components of a letter.
- 12. **Ransom words** Write your words by cutting out letters in a newspaper or magazine and gluing them into your spelling journal.
